### Competition open to:

Any member of a Civilian Marksmanship Program affiliated club, the B.H.R.&G.C., the National Rifle Association, or a USA shooting club. All competitors must have an eligibility affidavit & must complete a liability agreement at registration.

### Conditions governing match:

- A. Rules: as set forth in CMP competition rules.
- B. Course of Fire:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> stage: slow fire, prone, 20 rounds in 20 minutes.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> stage: rapid fire, prone from standing, 10 rounds in 80 seconds.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> stage: rapid fire, sitting, 10 rounds in 80 seconds.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> stage: slow fire, standing, 10 rounds in 10 minutes.

\* all stages will be shot at 200YARDS
- C. Rifles: 'as issued' U.S. rifles, caliber .30  
\* M1903 Springfield, M1917 Enfield, M1 Garand, 1941 Johnson, M1 Carbine
- D. Ammunition: CMP ammunition (.30-06) will be issued to each competitor.  
\* unfired ammunition, brass, & clips remain the property of B.H.R.&G.C.
- E. Entry Fee: \$35 for non-members . . . . \$10 for BHR&GC members.  
\* free parking . . . . no other fees
- F. Relay times:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> relay: signup at 1000, 'sight-in' and match at 1100
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> relay: signup at 1130, 'sight-in' and match at 1230
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> relay: signup at 1300, 'sight-in' and match at 1400

\* no 'advance registration'; 'first come, first served', gate opens at 0900
